Project Execution

Research on possible health implications of electromagnetic fields (EMF) exposure is being carried out by a number of research centers, laboratories and universities, supported by international, national and industrial funding bodies. The extent and diversity of research activities being undertaken makes it usually difficult to provide relevant, authoritative and timely input for policy development at the EU level (and elsewhere). Furthermore, research results can be misinterpreted, inappropriately applied to other sources or exposure conditions or may not adequately address the concerns of stakeholders having an interest in EMF emissions.

In order to properly address the issue of interpretation of scientific results on potential health effects of EMF, the European Commission lunched in March 2004, at the beginning of the 6th Framework Programme, the Coordination Action EMF-NET that ended on August 2008.

Over the last four year and half, EMF-NET has undoubtedly improved the understanding of EMF and health issues, and coordinated research activities. It has become one of the main international actors in this area. EMF-NET has collated research results from EU funded projects and other national and international actions, provided a regular update on EMF research (plans, priorities, gaps, prospects from on-going research, results) and relevant interpretation/advice for the facilitation of policy development options by the EU and other bodies. Such advice is expected to be of some help for EC to develop policy options related to public health and consumer protection, health and safety at work, European competitiveness, environmental issues. The EMF-NET European Fast Response Team (EFRT) on EMF and Health, answered, on extremely short notice, specific questions of the European Commission services concerning potential health impacts of EMF.

On a practical ground, in the course of its lifetime EMF-NET published more than 40 reports and 20 Fact Sheets and Expert Opinions, 4 EMF and health related volumes, and organized and co-organized various seminars, workshops and conferences on specific policy related EMF and health topics, being acknowledged in Europe and worldwide as representing an essential infrastructure for the interpretation of the research results in an area in which such assistance is of utmost importance. This is bringing European Union to lead the world in the approaching of such a sensitive issue as the possible EMF interactions with health.

In summary, EMF-NET provided the building blocks for the development of the appropriate policy options by the Commission, but in spite of all what has been done, there is still much more to achieve.

Interpretation of scientific data for use by policy-makers, standards setters, health and environmental authorities, industry and concerned stakeholders must be a continuous process, even more, as it is expected that many projects will be active within the 7th Framework programme. The new research projects at national level in the EU, need careful coordination, to try to avoid overlap and help national authorities concentrate on the European research agenda on EMF and health.

So far, such a crucial activity for Europe was only partially part of the mandate of EMF-NET, and cannot be delayed anymore.

As to the workers, in the context of the Directive 2004/40/EC, a wide discussion has already started about its implementation, technical aspects related to assessment of the actual exposure of workers (measurements and numerical calculations), occupational risk assessment and the role of occupational medicine. EMF-NET largely addressed these issues, but these activities should be continued after the end of the current action.

Similar considerations hold also for adequate risk communication, in which EMF-NET played its role in interpreting the main needs, providing advice and fast responses by the EFRT to EC Services, and this role also needs continuity.

As to new and emerging technologies, technological changes have been so rapid that science has been unable to assess potential health risks in a timely manner. There is a need for constant effort and vigilance on possible health effects from new and emerging technologies, to allow policy and health authorities to act in the most appropriate way.

Last but not least, we are in a European Union that is continuously extending its borders. EMF-NET played its role in the coordination with the research activities in the new member countries and other European countries outside the EU. A network of contacts was already established and should be maintained and supported to allow even more coordination, dialogue and harmonization. Discontinuity of these activities would lead to lose this important and efficient infrastructure.

EMF-NET has been very active, not only in the interpretation of scientific data for use by policy authorities and all concerned stakeholders, but also as a reference point for EMF related health issues for the European Commission and in Europe to consolidate scientific knowledge, facilitate interpretation of the data, increase transparency and public trust, and help define and coordinate further research. The established network of experts involved in EMF-NET is a huge added value of the action that should be continued to be supported.
